

Public Water System Representative:

Updates have been made to the <u>GA EPD LCRR Service Line Inventory (SLI) Spreadsheet</u>. The updated spreadsheet, as well as the GA EPD SLI Guidance, can be found on the <u>GA EPD Drinking Water</u> website. Minor updates were necessary to better aid in the seamless upload of the spreadsheet into the 120Water software.

All SLI submissions must be done through the 120Water PWS Portal by the compliance deadline of October 16, 2024. A water system representative must register, attend, and complete training to gain access to the water system's PWS Portal account. Training has already begun with more sessions to be added in 1Q2024. For upcoming trainings and Q&A sessions, please visit the PWS Training Registration Page. After reviewing the material and information submitted, the GA EPD has elected to **not approve Electrical Resistance Technology** as an acceptable method of investigation for service line material classification at this time. If a water system chooses an investigation method not specified by the State under 40 CFR §141.84(a)(3)(iv), State approval is required. If a water system wishes to submit an investigation method for approval, please contact the GA EPD Compliance Unit.
